Parish Council Meeting 25th July 2022

Due to bad weather the Parish Council meeting was held in The Old Post Office. There was 1 MOP present. Fly tipping in the village and at the Rickyard was discussed, there is now a gate on the Rickyard.

The pothole at the crossing has now been filled and the solar box on the pathway on the A435 has been removed. Planning applications were discussed and considered. There was also a discussion in regard to the new Windmill Barns mainly about the access road.

It was agreed to purchase and plant a Walnut tree in support of 'The Queens Green Canopy', this will be planted when recommended to do so, along with a plaque. The new average speed cameras were discussed at length and it was felt the speed of cars had already been reduced, which has to be a good thing for the village and school. Parish Council finances were discussed and approved. There were no reports from Coughton schools headmaster due to holiday and no reports were received from County Councillor Justin Kerridge or District Councillor Jill Foreman as neither were in attendance.

The Community appreciation award for 2022 was discussed. If there is someone in the village you feel deserves this award for their hard work and help in the village please forward their name to your Parish Councillor by the end of August.
