#### Parish Council Meeting 23rd January 2023

Drains are still awaiting jetting, the delay is due to the fact traffic lights will be needed. Planning applications were discussed and comments sent to SDC. The RFO was discussed as was the budget review and precept. A quote for the new decking at Coughton Cofe Primary School was given to the PC for them to review as the school are unable to use the decking at present. Majority of the funds have been received from the Community fund but they are short approx. £400.00. This is to be discussed by the PC. CC Kerridge informed us that Council Grants are now back up and running for community groups and DC Forman reported the district council are looking at the council tax at present. She also informed us that the green bin charge had raised quite a large sum.

Elections are due to take place on the 4<sup>th</sup> May and all voters will need a suitable form of photo ID or can apply for a voters authority certificate if no photo ID is available. The deadline for applications is the 25<sup>th</sup>April which can be done on the SDC or government website or in person to the council house.

Rubbish is being dropped in the village but it has been worse in Coughton Lane, mainly beer cans. Could we kindly ask that any litter is popped into relevant bins. The environment group will be having several litter picking days this spring/summer.

We are still having parking issues in the village at school time, with cars blocking driveways. The school has sent out newsletters, but could we kindly ask anyone parking in the lanes NOT to park over the edge or opposite driveways as the villagers are unable to access their homes

#### Parish Councillor Vacancy
