Roads & Drain Repairs / Flooding issues

Warwickshire County Highways have been supplied with a list of road problems in the village. They have now been to inspect these, we have received an email from highways confirming the list of jobs they are to undertake in the near future. Road Safety

We attended the zoom meeting on 15th April regarding speeding in the county. This was very informative and despite being told last year that we were not eligible to join the community speed watch group, because we have speed cameras on the A435. However, there is a possibility we can use the hand held devices on other roads in Coughton once we are able to join this group. We were also informed that there will be average speed cameras put along the A435 before the end of the year and in the meantime, I have been assured the council are looking to reinstate the speed cameras on the main road...watch this space! IF YOU ARE CONCERNED ABOUT SPEEDING THROUGH THE VILLAGE, WE WOULD LIKE TO ASK YOU TO JOIN THE COMMUNITY SPEEDWATCH GROUP, THIS WILL

ENTAIL ONLY A COUPLE OF HOURS A MONTH (IF THAT) TO CHECK THE SPEED OF CARS. IF WE DO NOT GET ENOUGH PEOPLE TO JOIN THIS GROUP THEN WE ARE LIMITED AS TO HOW MUCH WE CAN DO. WE HAVE TO BE SEEN TO BE PROACTIVE IN ORDER FOR THE DISTRICT COUNCIL AND POLICE TO LISTEN TO OUR REQUESTS.PLEASE CONTACT A MEMBER OF THE PARISH COUNCILTO PUT YOUR NAME FORWARD.
